

Advice for theory candidates

Here is some helpful information so you know what to expect on the day of your exam:

Before the exam

- Make sure you have pens, pencils, a ruler, a rubber and a pencil sharpener
- Bring your exam paper label with you - this should be stuck to the top right-hand corner of your exam paper once it has been handed to you. If your label has been mislaid then please ensure you write your name nice and clearly in the top right-hand corner of the exam paper in the space provided.
- You cannot bring a mobile phone or any other electronic device into the exam room, even if you do not intend to use it. Possession of a mobile phone may result in a penalty and possible disqualification
- Please aim to arrive about 10 minutes before the exam is due to start so that you have a chance to get settled

During the exam

- Remember to listen carefully to any instructions from the invigilators
- You will be given a blank piece of manuscript paper (for rough working)
- Check your work once you have completed the paper. You may leave the exam room any time after 40 minutes if you have finished
- When you have finished your exam, hand your exam paper and manuscript paper to an invigilator before you leave. Don't forget to check that you have stuck your exam label to the front of the paper or have written your name on the paper

After the exam

- We aim to publish all results online 4 weeks after the exam - certificates and mark forms take a little longer and will be in the post 6 weeks after the exam
